About PYIMS:

Pakistan Young Innovative Minds Society is an educational trust that is working to bring about educational reforms in society. At present it is associated with various international Education Organizations and Tournaments such as the IYPT (International Young Physicist's Tournament) the IChTo (International Chemistry Tournament), the IYNT (International Young Naturalist Tournament), and the ITYM (International Tournament for Young Mathematician). We are also associated with the World Council for Youth and Diplomacy NewYork and the BUCA IMSEF as well as the ISAC Olympiad. This year the organization was host to the IYPT'23, in Murree, Pakistan, with over 20 countries taking part. This event went down in the IUPAP (International Union of Pure and Applied Physics) events of the century list. We were also able to earn the collaboration of the Australian Institute of Physics for this cause. We hope the upcoming years will add to our efforts to reform education in Pakistan.

What is PYMT:

PYMT or Pakistan Young Medicos Tournament is a unique one-of-a-kind medical competition for undergraduate students of medicine that fuses hands-on medicine with research and patents. This event will go global in the upcoming year i.e 2024



Vision and Purpose:

The vision of this event is to uplift the standard and value of Pakistani Medical Graduates both nationally and internationally, by promoting spot thinking and research culture, within the medical community.

Who can participate?

A team of 6 medical students from 1st to final year of medical education along with only one house officer. (6+1= 7 team members)

The scoring system

Fibers the currency: fundamentally innovation-based evolution and regulatory scores.

Fibers are good for you, not only in your diet but also at Pakistan Young Medicos Tournament. They will act as your currency throughout the event. Need an alternative problem? Spend fibers! Out of time? Use your fibers to buy time! Need another teammate to cover for you? Fibers are your way out! And naturally, the team with the most fiber at the end wins the tournament.

Rules

The member who selects the particular question must answer it.

If any other member knows the answer they have to spend 2 fibers.

If they answer the question incorrectly they will loose x+2 points.

No member can answer/challenge 2 questions more than 2 times without spending fibers.

A "resource station" will be present to buy time and other resources.

Apt use of resources may get 5 fibers added, based on the discretion of the elevator.

Rules

One person at a time may go through the run.

- The person who is running the medical run must keep the baton with him/her at all times.
- If the runner wishes to replace/add something at any given station with any material from the resource station, he/she must buy it from the resource station.
- If the runner finds a station which he/she believes his/her team member can do better, he/she will spend 3 fibers.

In case of switching "runners" the baton must be handed over to the next "runner".

In case a team requires extra time for any given station they must spend fibers and buy time.

One supervisor from the management will stay with the runner gone with the team at all times.

• found the team will be charged a penalty of all existing fibers or may be disqualified.



Medical Fight #1


- The medical fights
- "Will revolve around a previously released medical problems" draws will decide opponents.
- It will start with a quiz (Buzzer round) winners will get 10 fibers and 2 chance to decide their role as reviewer, opponent and reporter on a particular report.
- If the opponent refuses and wants to take up another problem he/she must spend 50 fibers on the first and +20 fibers on each subsequent rejection 50+20=70, 70+29=90.
- 1 fight consists of 3 rounds and each round has multiple stages (see next).
- 3 teams, depending on total number of teams. 3 roles (Reporter, opponent, reviewer).

- 11. Discussion between opponent and reporter 10 min
- 12. Opponent summarizes discussion 1 min
- 13.Q/A by the reviewer to the opponent and 3 min
- 14. Presentation of reviewer
- 15. The reviewer takes the floor 4 min
- 16. Concluding remarks of the reporter 2 min
- 17. Questions of Jury 5 min




